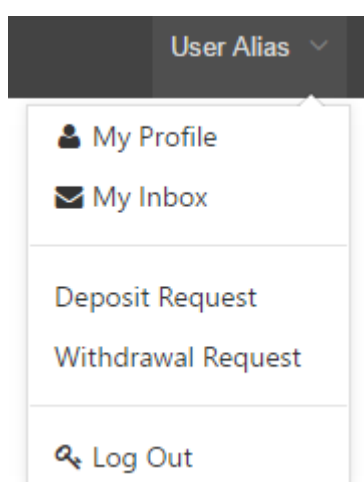
HOW TO WITHDRAW FUNDS



Step 1- Withdrawal request

You can withdraw funds which are in your ThinCats Cash Account at any time, there are two ways to begin this process:

When logged into your ThinCats Account on the homepage you will find a button labelled Withdrawal Request. Clicking this will display the form seen in step 2.



If you are elsewhere on the system, click on your user alias in the top right corner to produce a dropdown menu. From here you can click on the menu item labelled Withdrawal Request. Clicking this will display the form seen in step 2.

Step 2- Complete the request form

There are only 2 fields to fill out on the request form, everything else is pre-populated.

Amount: Enter the amount of cleared funds you wish to withdraw. If you are unsure how much you have free, your balance is always displayed in the header on the right-hand side.

Notes: Here you can specify any additional information we may potentially require. This field is not mandatory.

Click 'Post' when you have entered all the details to proceed. You will be taken to a confirmation screen where you will be asked to confirm the information you have entered. Click 'Confirm' and your withdrawal request will be submitted to our ThinCats Admin for processing.

Step 3 – Funds transfer

Once we have received your withdrawal request we will process the withdrawal. Any requests received before 12 noon will be processed the same day. Please note bank transfers can take 1 to 2 working days to arrive and withdrawals will only be processed Monday to Friday.

Bank holiday delays

During bank holidays there will be an additional working day added to the normal withdrawal time.

Your single nominated bank account

Due to the anti-money laundering laws and regulations you can only transfer money to and from your ThinCats account from a single nominated bank account. If you wish to change your nominated bank account please contact us at admin@thincats.com and we will be happy to help, but please be aware that we will have to conduct anti-money laundering checks on your new account.

Accessing invested funds

You will not be able to withdraw funds that are currently invested in loans or currently allocated to an auction. If you do wish to turn an investment into free funds you may be able to sell your loans on the Secondary Market. The price you will receive, and the ability to sell will depend on the availability of other ThinCats members who are willing to purchase your loan parts.
